Lockdown Drill



There will be a Lockdown Drill on November 22nd, this together with Fire Drills and Earthquake Drills are required by the Ministry of Education to help keep our children safe in an emergency.

For the little ones for whom it will be a first experience, your child's teacher will fully explain what will be done. Together with our school liaison officer, we will practice two drills. The "Lockout" Drill requires that the school doors be locked and the classroom doors are also locked.

"The Lockdown" Drill is for an incident where a dangerous person is inside the school for whatever reason. For this kind of incident, the children and staff hide in areas of the school where they can't be seen until the police arrive.


Sugar Free Month
